DAY 1 - OCTOBER 13 – DEPART CANADA

Board your overnight transatlantic flight to Dublin.

DAY 2 - OCTOBER 14 – ARRIVAL DUBLIN (2 NIGHTS)

DAY 9 - OCTOBER 21 – GALWAY – CLIFFS OF MOHER – SHANNON ESTUARY FERRY – KILLARNEY (2 NIGHTS)

Visit the magnificent Cliffs of Moher and see the history of the cliffs brought to life with a visit to the 'Atlantic Edge' exhibition. Enjoy a unique Be My Guest lunch located on the world famous Wild Atlantic Way. Our local friends will take you foraging for plants and seaweed before serving a delicious lunch made from local produce. Enjoy spectacular views of the dramatic coastline before boarding a ferry to cross the tranquil River Shannon estuary. Travel through beautiful Co.Kerry to your hotel in Killarney. This evening, why not enjoy the 'craic' at a traditional Irish ceilidh? **Full Breakfast, Be My Guest Dining**

DAY 10 - OCTOBER 22 - RING OF KERRY EXCURSION

Today we experience Ireland's most scenic coastal drive around the Iveragh Peninsula, better known as the Ring of Kerry. It is undoubtedly one of the most magical and varied places in the whole of Ireland and is truly a photographer's delight. On your journey we will see Killorglin set on Dingle Bay, which was the location for the film, Ryan's Daughter. We will also see Daniel O'Connell's Cahirciveen, the fishing village of Waterville, the Black Valley and Moll's Gap. Here mountains, valleys, lakes and sea blend into a landscape that is often breathtaking beyond words. **Full Breakfast, Dinner**

DAY 11 - OCTOBER 23 - KILLARNEY – BLARNEY – WATERFORD – KILKENNY
