Clementina's Captivating Calabria

September 4 to 19, 2018

Day 1 - Depart Toronto

Day 2 - Lamezia Terme - Tropea

Arrive in Lamezia, transfer to hotel. The rest of the day is free to explore.

Day 3 - Tropea - Aeolian Islands Tour

This morning travel by boat to visit the Aeolian Island of Vulcano, Lipari and Stromboli.

Day 4 - Tropea - Agrigento Sicily

Enjoy a guided tour of the Valley of the Temples in Agrigento. After lunch return to hotel with a stop in Acirele with free time.

Day 5 - Free day

Day at leisure. A complimentary shuttle service to the sea is available.

Day 6 - Tropea - Reggio Calabria - Scilla

Visit Reggio Calabria which features a Cathedral and the Archaeological Museum(\$). Free time to walk "the most beautiful Kilometer of Italy." Then, continue to Scilla which is dominated by the castle of the Ruffo that divides the town into two parts.

Day 7 -Tropea- Pizzo Calabro - Altomonte

Depart for Altomonte with a stop in Pizzo Calabro. While in Pizzo you will have time to sample their famous tartufo ice cream. Once arriving in Altomonte, enjoy a guided walking tour.

Day 8 - Altomonte - San Donato Di Ninea

Travel through the countryside to the small village of San Donato di Ninea. Visit the Mother Church Holy Trinity, Church of the Assumption, and the beautiful caves of Sant'Angelo. This afternoon visit Madonna del Pettoruto. Then enjoy a traditional dinner with music and dancing at Colle del Sogni.

Day 9 - Altomonte - Civita - Morano Calabro

Today, travel to Civita, a historical Albanian community of Italian-Albanians, in Pollino National Park. The area is referred to as the Devil's Bridge and its landscapes are among the most beautiful of Calabria. This afternoon visit Morano Calabro.

Day 10 - Altomonte - Rossano

Depart for Rossano Calabro. Visit St Mark's Church, one of the most important churches of Byzantine origin. Then partake in an afternoon tour of the Licorice factory.

Day 11 - Altomonte - Cosenza

Enjoy a city tour of Cosenza by "open air" bus. Afternoon at leisure with the opportunity to shop along the "Corso Mazzini".

Day 12 - Altomonte

Visit a small ranch and have the option to go horseback riding.

Day 13 - Altomonte

Depart for Scalea with afternoon visits to San Nicola Arcella and Praia a Mare.

Day 14 - Scalea - Maratea

Visit Maratea overlooking a magnificent stretch of sea including a stop at Monte San Biagio to see the statue of Maratea.

Day 15 - Scalea

Enjoy a 3 hour cruise to Dino Island with a visit to the Blue Grotto. As we move to the north side of the island, we will see numerous coves, among which will be the spectacular Grotto of Monaco.
