Clementina's Captivating Calabria

September 4 to 19, 2018

Day 1 - Depart Toronto

Day 2 - Altomonte

Transfer to the Hotel in Altomonte -Hotel Barbieri. Visit the town of Altomonte followed by dinner at the Cantina Barbieri.

Day 3 - Altomonte -San Donato di Ninea

Travel the countryside to the small village of San Donato Di Ninea and then visit the Sanctuary of The Modonna del Pettoruto. This evening enjoy a traditional Calabrese meal at Colle del Sogni.

Day 4 - Altomonte - Civita - Morano Calabro

Transfer to the village of Civita. The village, located in Pollino National Park, among the Albanian historical communities of Italy. Also called Devils Bridge, its landscapes are defined as one of the most beautiful in Calabria. Travel to the "La Locanda del Parco" farm for lunch. In the afternoon visit Morano Calabro.

Day 5 - Altomonte - Rossano

Visit Rossano Calabro for a guided tour of the Church of San Marco, considered one of the most important churches of Byzantine origins. Also visit the Diocesan Museum where the famous Codex Purpureo Rosanensis is kept. In the afternoon, tour the "Amarelli" liquorice factory.

Day 6 - Altomonte - Cosenza - Diamante

Enjoy a guided tour of Cosenza, followed by free time to explore. Then continue to Diamante.

Day 7 - Diamante

Enjoy some leisure time by the sea.

Day 8 - Diamante - Maratea

Take a guided tour of Diamante, Santa Maria del Cedro. In the afternoon visit of Scalea and Praia Mare.

Day 9 - Diamante - Maratea

Visit Maratea, the town overlooks a magnificent stretch of sea including a stop at Monte San Biagio to see the statue of Maratea.

Day 10 - Diamante - San Nicola Arcelli

Enjoy a three hour cruise to Dino Island with a visit to the Blue Grotto. As we move to the north side of the island, we will see numerous coves, among which will include the spectacular Grotto of Monaco. Later we journey to Capo Vaticano.

Day 11 - Capo Vaticano - Tropea

Enjoy some leisure time in the morning, later in the day visit Tropea.

Day 12 - Capo Vaticano - The Aeolian Islands

This morning travel by boat to visit the Aeolian Island of Vulcano, Lipari and Stromboli.

Day 13 - Capo Vaticano - Agrigento

Enjoy a guided tour of the Valley of the Temples in Agrigento. After lunch return to the hotel with a stop in Acirele for free time.

Day 14 - Capo Vaticano

Explore Capo Vaticano on your own. In the afternoon, enjoy an excursion to Tropea, or Pizzo Calabro.

Day 15 - Capo Vaticano - Reggio Calabria

Visit Reggio Calabria which features a Cathedral and the Archaeological Museum (*admission not included*). Free time to walk "The most beautiful Kilometer of Italy". Then continue to Scilla.

Day 16 - Return Home

After breakfast depart for the Lamezia airport for your return flight to Toronto.
