## Wednesday, March 20

We depart for Beaufort, South Carolina to enjoy a Horse-Drawn Carriage Tour. On this one-hour tour, let the clippity-clop of the horses take you back to a simpler time. Re-live the past through the narration of the professional guides while learning about Antebellum architecture, as well as view local Hollywood movie sites. Leave for our next stop, Savannah, Georgia for our two-night stay at the **River Street Inn**. Dinner is included tonight.

## Thursday, March 21

Highlights of our Savannah "windshield" driving tour includes 2.2 square miles of the Historic District's rich history, with restored 18th and 19th century buildings, and the picturesque waterfront, where cotton warehouses are now restaurants, hotels, and shop. If available, we will tour the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist, built in 1873. Lunch is at the Crab Shack, with 78 live baby alligators! In the afternoon, enjoy a guided

tour of the Low Country, viewing outlying areas that showcase river inlets, marshes and tidal creeks. Travel to Tybee Island for an overview of the island's unique coastal living style.

## Friday, March 22

This morning, we depart for Chattanooga, Tennessee, known as America's Scenic City. Enjoy the River City Sessions, a new variety dinner show featuring Bluegrass and Americana music, along with storytelling and comedy in the Appalachian Roots traditions. Our two-night stay is at the **Staybridge Suites Chattanooga Hamilton Place**.

## Saturday, March 23

Following breakfast, we leave for the incline's trolley-style cars that climb through the natural beauty surrounding historic Lookout Mountain. Located atop Lookout Mountain, Rock City is a true marvel of nature, featuring massive ancient rock formations, gardens with over 400 native plant species, and breathtaking "See 7 States" panoramic views. Enjoy a guided city tour which includes the iconic Chattanooga Choo Choo, Bluff View Art District, Chattanooga National Cemetery and more. At the end of the day, cruise the scenic Tennessee River and enjoy live music with our dinner.

We depart beautiful Chattanooga to begin the first part of our journey home. Tonight, we overnight in Columbus, Ohio. We will make frequent stops during the day.
