## Day 1 - Depart Toronto

Travel overnight from Toronto to Dublin.

## Day 2 - Arrive in Dublin

Travel to Cork with an en-route visit to the Rock of Cashel. Enjoy dinner at the Maldon Hotel South Mall Cork.

## Day 3 - Cork

In the morning, explore Cork on your own. Later in the day journey to Cobh to tour the Cobh Heritage Centre. Visit the Jameson Experience to hear the history of Irish Whiskey, tour the old distillery and taste some Irish Whiskeys. Dinner this evening is at the South County Pub in Douglas Cork.

## Day 4 - Cork to Killarney

Depart for Killarney to visit the Blarney Castle and Blarney Woollen Mills. Continue over the Cork and Kerry Mountains through the colourful towns and villages. Upon arrival, spend a free afternoon in Killarney. Tonight, dinner will be at the Killarney Plaza Hotel.

## Day 5 - Killarney

Circuit of the Ring of Kerry then enjoy lunch in a Pub on the Ring of Kerry. Later, visit the Kissanee Sheep Farm. Dinner this evening will be at the Kate Kearney's Cottage at Gap of Dunloe.

## Day 6 - Kilkenny to Galway

Depart for Galway, by ferry over the Shannon River Crossing. Later we continue up the west coast along the Wild Atlantic Way to visit the Cliffs of Moher, then through the Burren, Co Clare and along the southern shore of Galway Bay to Galway. Dinner tonight will be at Menlo Park Hotel Galway.

## Day 7 - Galway

Today, we visit Kylemore Abbey and Gardens. Later enjoy a lunch cruise on the Killary Harbour. Dinner tonight will be at the Busker Brownes Pub Galway.

## Day 8 - Galway to Lough Eske

Depart for Lough Eske travelling through Counties Galway, Mayo, Sligo and Donegal. Briefly cross the border into Northern Ireland to visit Belleek Fine China Factory before arriving in the mid-afternoon to enjoy the facilities at Lough Eske 5 Star Castle Hotel. Tonight have dinner at Lough Eske Castle where we will stay for two nights.

## Day 9 - Lough Eske

Spend the day at Lough Eske to enjoy the Castle and it's facilities, or partake in the optional tour to London Derry and Giants Causeway (no extra charge).

## Day 10 - Lough Eske to Dublin

Travel to Dublin via Enniskillen Castle and visit Corlea Bog Track before arriving in Dublin late afternoon. Dinner will be at Brannigans Bar, and we will overnight at the Gresham Hotel Dublin.

## Day 11 - Dublin

Tour Dublin with a local tour guide. Enjoy visits to Trinity College, the Book of Kells and Christchurch Cathedral. The afternoon is free to explore Dublin. Our farewell dinner will be at Merry Ploughboys for a traditional Irish night.

## Day 12 - Depart Dublin/Return to Toronto

This morning travel to the airport for your flight home.
