Day 1 - Thursday, July 23

Fly to the west coast to start your seaside adventure in Seattle, Washington.

Day 2 - Friday, July 24

Enjoy a guided city tour of Seattle this morning to get more familiarized with the local area. Once the group is feeling more like Seattleites, we will travel to T-Mobile Park for a stadium tour, visiting areas normally restricted to the public. In the afternoon, head to Pike Place Market, one of the oldest running farmer's markets overlooking Elliot Bay, for a late lunch & shopping. Here, find the freshest seafood in the city along with other fantastic food & craft stalls. A stop will be made at the hotel before heading to the evening baseball game.

Day 3 - Saturday, July 25

B

Start the morning cruising Elliott Bay with sweeping views of the Olympic Mountains, Puget Sound & Seattle's shipping port. From the Bay, travel to Seattle Center, originally designed for the 1962 World Fair. This central area is home to the Chihuly Garden & Glass museum displaying exhibits of a local glass sculptor. Like something

out of Alice in Wonderland, the gardens are filled with vibrant colours at every turn. In the afternoon, travel north of Seattle to the Boeing Everett Factory, an airplane assembly plant owned by Boeing Aerospace Company. Explore the interactive exhibits & displays before taking a guided tour of the plant where you can observe the aircraft assembly plant.

Day 4 - Sunday, July 26

B

Spend the morning at leisure or opt in to join the group on a Starbucks coffee facility tour and tasting at the Starbucks Headquarters. Starbucks coffee chain originated from the Seattle area with the original coffee shop opening at Pike Place Market, still open today. Discuss brewing techniques, tasting basics and everything coffee! This afternoon we head back to T-Mobile Park for the second Toronto Blue Jays game.

Day 5 - Monday, July 27

Our tour comes to an end today as we head to the airport for our flight home.
