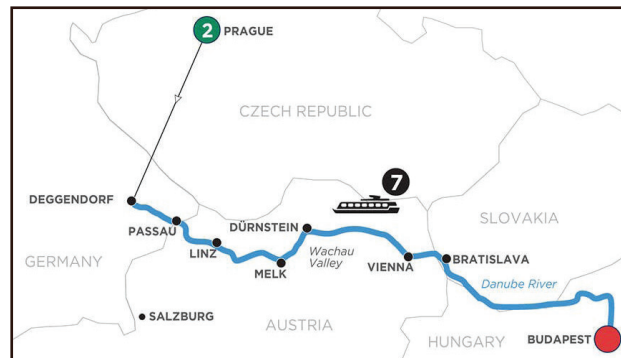

Day 2 - Prague, Czech Republic
