The monks make cheese and apple cider, which we will have the opportunity to taste. Lunch on our own in Magog with time to discover this lakeside village, located on the shores of Lake Memphremagog. In the afternoon, travel to Fitch Bay to visit Bleu Lavande Farm, the largest lavender farm in Canada. Enjoy a guided tour and short film describing the history of Bleu Lavande, to learn about the culture of lavender. Dinner at the resort.
