#### SUNDAY, JUNE 27

#### MONDAY, JUNE 28

We start our day with a guided visit to The Hopewell Rocks Ocean Tidal Exploration Site. The Hopewell Rocks are also called the Flowerpot Rocks which is caused by the tidal erosion. There may be an opportunity to walk on the ocean floor. After our interesting morning at Hopewell Rocks we depart for Halifax Spend the next three nights in Halifax. Accommodations: Halifax Marriott Harbourfront or similar

TUESDAY, JUNE 29

This morning, meet your local guide for a tour of Halifax, the capital of Nova Scotia. After the tour, leave for Peggy's Cove for a lunch and visit. Tonight, enjoy the Royal Nova Scotia International Tattoo, a unique maritime experience. The "Tattoo" is an extravaganza with continuous music and unique acts, featuring the Canadian military, along with military units from other countries. It features hundreds of bag pipes and drum corps with incredible precision marching. Everything unique to the spirit that is Canada and the Maritimes.

#### WEDNESDAY, JUNE 30

Following breakfast, visit Pier 21 where thousands of immigrants entered Canada to find a better life. This afternoon there is the option of visiting Lunenburg (with transportation) or enjoy free time to explore the beautiful city of Halifax.

#### THURSDAY, JULY 1

Following an early breakfast, we depart for the city of Sydney on Cape Breton Island, our home away from home for the next two nights. On our way, visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site. **Accommodations:** Cambridge Suites or similar

## FRIDAY, JULY 2

Today, spend the day on the Cabot Trail, one of the world's most scenic destinations. Our local guide will be delighted to show the beauty and wonderment of the Cabot Trail. A stop will be made at the Keltic Lodge for lunch. Return to the hotel by dinnertime.

## SATURDAY, JULY 3

Following an early breakfast, we leave for Caribou, Nova Scotia to board a ferry to Prince Edward Island. We arrive at Wood's Island, PEI and drive to Charlottetown, our home for the next two nights. Tonight, enjoy a lobster dinner at the Fisherman's Wharf Restaurant.
