WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 11

Depart Toronto to Calgary. Upon arrival, transfer to your downtown hotel with the remainder of the day at leisure. Welcome dinner.

Accommodations: Hotel Arts Calgary or similar

THURSDAY, AUGUST 12

Banff - Morning city tour of Calgary then journey to the foothills. Stop in Canmore en route to Banff. Take time to explore shops and eateries before check-in at the hotel.

Accommodations: Ptarmigan Inn Banff or similar

FRIDAY, AUGUST 13

Begin with a Banff sightseeing tour, including the Lake Minnewanka Loop and the Bow Valley Parkway. Later, ride the Banff Gondola up to Sulphur Mountain for dinner.

SATURDAY, AUGUST 14

Depart for Johnston Canyon, the continental divide and Yoho National Park. Stop for lunch at Emerald Lake. In the afternoon, arrive at Lake Louise and visit Moraine Lake.

Accommodations: Lake Louise Inn or similar

SUNDAY, AUGUST 15

Drive along the famous Icefields Parkway. Stop at The Crossings for a thrilling view of the Rockies by helicopter. Continue to the Columbia Ice Fields and ride on the ice explorer vehicle.

Accommodations: The Crimson Jasper or similar

MONDAY, AUGUST 16

Start the day with a gondola ride, followed by sightseeing from Jasper to Maligne Canyon and Maligne Lake. Cruise the lake with a short stop at Spirit Island. Dinner at the Maligne Lake Boathouse ends the day.

TUESDAY, AUGUST 17

Travel to Edmonton. Upon arrival, tour the city including the Legislature and River Valley Parkway, ending at West Edmonton Mall. Remainder of the day at leisure before a farewell dinner in the evening.

Accommodations: Fantasyland Hotel Edmonton or similar

WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 18

Transfer to the airport for your return flight to Toronto.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A non-refundable deposit of \$600 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due May 7, 2021. Bookings made after May 7 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

May 6 or more prior	Deposit non-refundable
May 7 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

Local laws and customs: The Government of Ontario requires that residents travelling out of province to be advised that there may be different living standards with respect to the provision of utilities, services and accommodations outside of Ontario. Travel Act Regulation 38(06)

Moderate Pace: Tour requires average physical activity. Traveller should be in good physical health, able to climb stairs, be comfortable standing, and walking moderate distances including uneven surfaces. Itineraries typically include more longer than shorter days.
