POINTS OF INTEREST

■ KENTUCKY DERBY MUSEUM

With two floors of interactive, family friendly exhibits, the Kentucky Derby Museum takes visitors through every stage of a Thoroughbred's life, from birth to the First Saturday in May. Learn about all the great history of the race dating back to the inaugural running in 1875 to our most recent Kentucky Derby champion and experience all the traditions that have transformed the race into what it is today.

■ FARMINGTON HISTORIC HOME

Life on a Kentucky Plantation, Farmington is a 14-room Federal-style home that was the center of the 19th-century hemp plantation of John and Lucy Speed. Designed from a plan by Thomas Jefferson and completed in 1816 using slave labor, the house is newly restored with original paint colors, historic wallpaper and carpets, and furnished with Kentucky furniture and other antiques from the period.

■ LOUISVILLE SLUGGER MUSEUM & FACTORY

Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory is all about celebrating the extraordinary role of Louisville Slugger in baseball's past, present and future. Visitors can view collections of baseball memorabilia before moving on to the manufacturing facility to see bats being produced.

■ EVAN WILLIAMS BOURBON

Take a trip down the Kentucky Bourbon Trail and get a taste of their Bourbon's rich history. Located on Louisville's historic "Whiskey Row," the Evan Williams Bourbon experience features artisanal distillery, guided tours, educational Bourbon Tasting, and more! Celebrating the legacy of Evan Williams, Kentucky's first commercial distiller, this immersive experience brings to life the history and tradition of Kentucky's native spirit

■ MUHAMMAD ALI CENTER

A visit to the Center is not just an experience, but a journey into the heart of a boxing native champion. The Center's three levels of award-winning exhibits and galleries invite visitors to explore Muhammad Ali's legendary life, as well as to reflect upon one's own individual values, inner strength, character, and what makes you the greatest person you can be. Take a breathtaking journey through the Center's interactive and multimedia exhibits and discover the six core principles that Muhammad Ali embraced.
