

## ■ SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 18

Overnight flight, Toronto to Edinburgh.

## ■ MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 19

DW

Arrive in Scotland. Check in at your hotel and take some time to relax. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner this evening.

## ■ TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 20

B

Join a Local Expert to see the highlights of the city. In the Old Town, view the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official Scottish residence of the Queen. Drive along Princes Street to the ornate Scott Memorial, then see the 18th century New Town with its neoclassical Georgian facades. Venture up the Royal Mile to visit Edinburgh Castle, home of Mons Meg, the Stone of Destiny and Scotland's Crown Jewels, the Honours of Scotland. The rest of the day is at leisure.

## ■ WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 21

B, AT, DW

Cross the Firth of Forth into Fife and journey to St. Andrews, passing the Old Course, home of golf since its creation in the 15th century. Enjoy free time to explore. Options include strolling to West Sands Beach or wandering to St. Andrews University. Cross the Tay and journey to the charming Victorian resort town of Pitlochry, famous for its salmon run. Continue via Blair Atholl and pass the Grampian Mountains on the way to Spey Valley. Stop at Blair Castle and Gardens where you can tour the Ballroom, learn about the history of the estate and relish a delicious cream tea. Continue to Inverness, where your luxury hotel is set within four acres of manicured grounds.

## ■ THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 22

See Culloden Moor in the morning, where Bonnie Prince Charlie's Jacobite army was crushed in 1746. Visit the Culloden Visitor Centre before continuing along the shores of Loch Ness. Keep your eyes peeled for the legendary monster! Next, follow the rugged coast north to the fishing port of Wick. Explore Wick with Insight Choice. Choose to visit the Old Pulteney Distillery to taste a wee dram of whiskey or visit the highly rated Wick Heritage Museum and hear about the past of this once thriving fishing community.

## ■ FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 23

B, DW

Start the day by driving to the most northern point of the British mainland, John O'Groats. Board a ferry to the Orkney Islands where the countryside is breathtaking. Your Local Expert accompanies you as you visit the 5,000-year-old village of Skara Brae, the mysterious Ring of Brodgar, Kirkwall and the small chapel built by Italian prisoners in WWII.

## ■ SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 24

B, DW

Travel through stunning landscapes along the north coast with its white sandy beaches, and inland to misty valleys and glens, lochs and rushing waters. Then it's 'Over the Sea to Skye,' the largest and most beautiful island of the Inner Hebrides. On the way to Broadford, learn how young Flora MacDonald helped rescue Bonnie Prince Charlie and see the dramatic Cuillin Hills.

## ■ SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 25

B, DW

Explore this wild and beautiful island on your own, before crossing to the Kyle of Lochalsh. Stop for a photo at the remote Eilean Donan Castle. Move on to the WWII Commando Memorial where there is a fine view of Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain. You'll enjoy more spectacular scenery en route to the Valley of Glencoe. In the evening, enjoy market-fresh Scottish ingredients and wine, as you get together with your new friends for a sumptuous Celebration Dinner.

## ■ MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26

B

Spend time around peaceful Loch Lomond, 'Queen of Scottish Lochs' according to Sir Walter Scott and the largest in Great Britain. Consider experiencing the beauty of the loch with an optional cruise before continuing to Glasgow. An orientation drive through the city will show you the grand public buildings, including George Square and St. Mungo's Cathedral. Then the rest of the afternoon is at your leisure to explore as you wish.
