HILO, HAWAII



How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A deposit of \$670 per cabin is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due November 26, 2021. Bookings made after November 26 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Until November 26	Deposit refundable
November 27 to January 28	50% non-refundable
lanuary 29 to March 28	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
