MONDAY, APRIL 18

Our early morning departure takes us through New York State with frequent breaks along the way.

Following breakfast, we travel southwest, passing St. Louis, arriving in lively Branson by suppertime. Today, we put our watches back one hour. Arrive in Branson and check into our hotel for a five-night stay. Dinner is on our own tonight. **Accommodations:** Hilton Branson Convention Center Downtown

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 20

We begin our day by meeting our local tour guide for the "Top of the Rock Complex" visit. Here, enjoy a self-guided golf cart tour of the Lost Canyon and Cave Trail. We visit the Museum of the Ancient Ozarks and continue with a tour of Branson. This evening, enjoy the Clay Cooper's Country Music Express Show. Dinner is our own.

THURSDAY, APRIL 21

We start our day by departing for Springfield, Missouri to visit the Fantastic Caverns. These caverns are the only caves in North America to offer a completely ride-through tour with a Jeep-drawn tram. The tram drives along the path left behind by an ancient underground river. Lunch today is in Ozark, Missouri. This afternoon is free to relax. Enjoy the Haygood's performance this evening.

FRIDAY, APRIL 22

This morning, depart for Dogwood Canyon Nature Park. Step aboard an open-air tram and explore the beauty of Dogwood Canyon on our guided Wildlife Tour. You will wind through the canyon floor, past towering bluffs and waterfalls, crossing creek beds by way of beautiful-crafted stone bridges, and splashing through spring-fed waters. The tour continues into Arkansas where herds of bison, elk, whitetail deer and longhorn cattle roam the upper reaches of the Canyon. After a cook-out lunch, return to hotel for quick freshening up and leave for the College of the Ozarks tour and dinner. After such a busy day, enjoy a relaxing evening at the hotel.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A nonrefundable deposit of \$200 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due February 16, 2022. Bookings made after February 16 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

Moderate Pace: Tour requires average physical activity. Traveller should be in good physical health, able to climb stairs, be comfortable standing, and walking moderate distances including uneven surfaces. Itineraries typically include more longer than shorter days.
