Following breakfast, we travel south through Kentucky to Tennessee. We check into the beautiful Guest House at Graceland Hotel situated in the heart of Elvis Presley's Graceland.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31

We begin our day with an audio-guided tour to Elvis Presley's Graceland Mansion including the new Orientation Film. We will have full access to state of the art Visitor Entertainment Complex, Elvis' Two Custom Airplanes, Elvis Presley Car Museum, Elvis: The Entertainer Career Showcase Museum and Elvis Discovery Exhibits. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of the Sun Studio. Next we visit the Stax Studio. Many of the artists and musicians who recorded at Stax were from surrounding neighbourhoods, local churches and schools. In a time when racial tension was high, this studio never saw race but rather focused on producing its own sound - a Memphis sound that would be heard around the world. Dinner is included tonight.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1

Today, depart for Nashville with a stop at Johnny Cash's Hideaway Farm & Storytellers Museum in Bon Aqua. This is where Johnny called it "the center of his universe" his secret getaway. We continue our drive to Nashville for a guided tour of the Grand Ole Opry House Backstage Tour. End the day with a delicious meal and be entertained by one of Nashville's most successful songwriters. This is a unique opportunity to hear major hit songs in their original form and get the inside scoop on what was going on in the songwriter's life that inspired these classics.
