#### Barcelona

This coastal city exudes European charm! Barcelona has with must-see architectural gems that date back some 2,000 years. Encounter fascinating examples from the Roman Empire, the Middle Ages, the Modern masters like Gaudî, and many Cataluñian greats. Art museums can be found throughout the city, displaying the works of world-renowned artists, including Goya, Pablo Picasso & Salvador Dalî.

### Provence, Marseille, France

Stroll the charm of France's oldest city - along La Canabiere toward the Vieux Port where ships have docked for more than 26 centuries, or in Cours Julien, a large pedestrian square lined with some of Marseille's trendiest caf&eacutes and theatres.

### Nice, France

This jewel of the French Riviera is home to some of the world's most luxurious hotels and terraced cafes. Stroll the ultra-famous Promenade des Anglais or see masterpieces by Matisse, Renoir, Monet, and Chagall in one of Nice's many museums.

## Florence/Pisa, LaSpezia, Italy

La Spezia is just minutes to the east of Cinque Terre - the five fishing ports that enjoy National Park status - is home to the Palio del Golfo, an annual boat race that 13 historic villages face off against one another in celebration of Festa del Mare.

### Ajaccio, Corsica, France

On the west coast of Corsica lies Ajaccio, the island's largest town. Enjoy the charm and sophistication with its palm trees, sandy beaches, bountiful shopping, and colorful cafes, bars, and bistros. Famed for being Napoleon Bonaparte's birthplace, Ajaccio tips its hat to its most famous and storied resident throughout the town.

### Genoa, Italy

Welcome to one of the busiest harbors in Europe and Christopher Columbus' home city. Genoa is bordered on one side by the ocean, and on the other by mountains. In the lower city, find cobblestone streets, interlaced in alleyways and unique shopping. This port city is where Columbus set sail to the New World.

### Rome, Italy

Once the center of the Ancient World from which emperors ruled over nearly all of western civilization, Rome is still a cultural mecca. Only a few cities in the world can boast a well-preserved level of architecture, art, and religious iconography. Visit the ancient halls of the 50,000-seat Colosseum, and gaze upon the ceilings of Sistine Chapel in the Vatican City.

### Naples, Italy

Framed by Mount Vesuvius along a dramatic skyline, the 2,800 year-old port city of Naples is chock full of historical sites, churches, and museums that make it a fascinating place to explore. Bookings made after June 9 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

**Cancellation charges:** Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:
