MONDAY, MAY 20BB, D

Lunch on our own at the Atlanta's Market/ Food Hall. Explore the fascinating story of Coca-Cola- the world's best-known beverage. Tonight, enjoy a traditional Southern meal.

TUESDAY, MAY 21BB, D

After breakfast - Begin the day with a guided tour of the Atlanta Botanical Garden. Thirty acres of display gardens and shady woodlands featuring plant collections including roses, herbs, conifers, and carnivorous plants. Special features include the Dorothy Chapman Fuqua Conservatory, home to rare and endangered tropical and desert plants and so much more. Next, visit the Center for Puppetry Arts, an experience unlike anything else in the World!! With a guided tour, get ready to rethink everything you know about puppets and puppeteers, from ancient to contemporary. Collection Highlights include the Jim Henson Gallery, Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade balloon inventor Tony Sarg to Japanese Bunraku puppets donated by master puppeteer and Living National Treasure Kiritake Kanjuro III. Lunch on our own. Visit the National Center for Civil and Human Rights with a self-guided tour. The National Center for Civil and Human Rights is a museum and cultural institution that connects the U.S. Civil Rights Movement to human rights challenges today. Dinner is included tonight.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 22BB, L, D

This morning we leave for Cincinnati with a stop in Chattanooga. Visit the Rock City Gardens – self-guided tour. Located atop Lookout Mountain. Rock City is a true marvel of nature featuring massive ancient rock formations and gardens with over 400 native plant species. Be amazed by the breathtaking "See 7 States" panoramic views. Lunch is included. We then travel to Cincinnati, where we check in our hotel. Dinner tonight is included at the hotel.

THURSDAY, MAY 23BB, D

Today explore the sights and sounds of Cincinnati on a two-hour tour of Cincinnati, learn about the German heritage, and hear some famous folk tales.
