■ WEDNESDAY, MARCH 6

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is due at the time of booking. Balance of payment is due, December 20, 2023. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

December 20 days or more prior	Deposit non-refundable
December 21 to January 20	50% non-refundable The day
January 21 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
