Amsterdam, Netherlands

Amsterdam is a vibrant tapestry of Dutch culture, where historic estates blend with the lively Red Light District along picturesque canals. Experience the energy of Dam Square, browse the Bloemenmarkt for fresh blooms, and immerse yourself in Rembrandt's art at the Rijksmuseum.

Flam, Norway

Flam is a picturesque village nestled at the end of the Aurlandsfjorden, boasting stunning natural beauty with the world's deepest fjord reaching a staggering 1,308 meters. Take a scenic ride on the Flam Railway, explore Otternes Farm Village, marvel at Stalheimsfossen waterfall, and enjoy panoramic views of the fjord from Stegastein viewpoint.

Arctic Circle

Looking for adventure in an out-of-the-ordinary destination with immense, raw beauty? Welcome to the Arctic Circle, the most northern of the five major circles of latitude. Discover its wild beauty and unique experiences, from vast horizons to vibrant cultures. Witness the Midnight Sun, meet indigenous peoples, and admire the diverse wildlife in this remote region of breathtaking landscapes.

Tromso, Norway

Tromso, Norway's gateway to the Arctic, is surrounded by deep blue fjords and snow-capped mountain peaks. Explore this lively city, linked to the mainland by a gracefully arched bridge. Visit the Polar Museum, take a cable car to Storstein Mountain, and indulge in local delicacies like carrot and cardamom marmalade.

Honningsvag, Norway

Situated above the Arctic Circle, Honningsvag is surrounded by fjords and waterfalls, offering views across the sea to the Svalbard Islands and the North Pole. First settled more than 10 thousand years ago, today it has a modern downtown area around the harbor. Explore Sami culture, visit Nordkappmuseet, and savour local cuisine like king crab risotto.

Molde, Norway

Molde, known as the Town of Roses, boasts scenic fjords and vibrant cultural events. Enthusiastic for the outdoors? Take one of the world's most iconic drives: Molde's Atlantic Road, voted the Norwegian Construction of the Century – drive over the ocean through islands, bays, and moorlands.

Olden, Norway

Fresh air and icy beauty are the hallmarks of Olden, known as the Gateway to the Glaciers. This town offers breathtaking views and outdoor adventures. Explore Jostedalbreen National Park, hike the blue ice of Jostedal Glacier, and discover contemporary design in this picturesque town.

Alesund, Norway

Alesund is a small, lively city with a unique modern feel. From the city park, walk up the 418 steps to the city's peak, Aksla and be rewarded with a gorgeous view on the city, the islands and the rugged Sunnmorsalpane mountain range. Alesund is also home to Norway's largest cod fishing – taste the delicious and fresh seafood dishes.

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A non-refundable deposit \$500 per person, plus deposit required by cruise line. Balance due May 1, 2024. Bookings made after May 1 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

May 1 or more prior	Deposit non-refundable
May 2 to June 2	50% non-refundable
June 3 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
