MONDAY, OCTOBER 21

Fly to the famous city of New Orleans, known for its Mardi Gras celebrations and Creole hospitality. A complex system of levees, drainage canals and pumps keep the city dry, as it is located below sea level. Enjoy a four-night stay at the gateway of the French Quarter.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 22

Explore New Orleans with a local guide on a sightseeing tour including the French Quarter – the heart and soul of the city, the above ground cemetery, and Café du Monde – the historic, open-air coffee stand that has been a fixture since 1862 serving beignet. Following lunch, experience the unique adventure of a narrated Louisiana swamp tour, possibly getting up close with an alligator.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 23

Plantations in Louisiana are one of the most sought-after attractions throughout the state. The Houmas House Estate allows visitors to experience the life on a sugarcane plantation in the 1800's. The mansion has been restored to the antebellum era, reflecting the opulence and wealth this sugarcane farm boasted in the 1880's. After a guided tour, enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, visit Oak Alley Plantation before returning to the city of New Orleans.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 24

Today is free to explore New Orleans on your own. The dinner this evening is onboard the Steamboat Natchez, while it cruises the mighty Mississippi River. Viewing the city from this stern-wheel steamboat, enjoying a buffet of New Orleans favourites, and being serenaded by a jazz band is a delightful experience.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

60 days or more prior	Deposit non-refundable
59 to 30 days prior	50% non-refundable
29 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

Easy Pace: Tour moves at a leisurely pace involving minimal physical activity which includes standing, walking short distances and climbing some steps. A mixture of longer and shorter days with scheduled free time.
