THURSDAY, MAY 22

Depart Toronto for Milan.

Arrive in Lake Como and check into your hotel.

Be treated to a walking tour of Lake Como, a former glacial lake and popular resort area for the rich and famous since Roman times. Gaze at the azure waters and impressive villas that line the lakeside from the hills above and perhaps recognize the scenery from such Hollywood blockbusters as Ocean's Twelve and Casino Royale.

SUNDAY, MAY 25

Board a boat for a scenic ride to Bellagio on Lake Como. Enjoy postcardperfect views strolling along the lakeside or exploring cobbled streets Browse shops, savour local fare at Bellagio's restaurants, and return by boat

MONDAY, MAY 26

Check out of your Lake Como hotel and en route to Basel, be treated to a Bellinzona orientation tour. Once you arrive in Basel, embark your ship, the AmaSerena, for your Rhine Castles & Swiss Alps cruise.

TUESDAY, MAY 27

Discover Basel, Switzerland's third-largest city, with its medieval town hall, lively market square, and 18th-century patrician homes. Explore on foot, join a guided bike tour across three countries, or choose a full-day excursion to Lake Lucerne. Marvel at the Lion Monument's poignant memorial and admire Lake Lucerne's medieval walls and towers from the 13th century.

WEDNESDAY, MAY 28

Explore the cross-cultural charm of Strasbourg, situated on the border of France and Germany. Take a panoramic tour featuring Parc de l'Orangerie, the European Parliament, and Place de la République. Stroll through the fairytale-like "La Petite France" district and wander charming streets past Cathédrale de Nôtre Dame with its famous astronomical clock. Alternatively, enjoy a guided bike ride through the city and Parc de l'Orangerie.

THURSDAY, MAY 29

Ludwigshafen offers four exciting excursions. Explore Heidelberg, a well-preserved medieval city along Germany's Castle Road, featuring the iconic Heidelberg Castle and the 18th-century Great Vat. For an active experience, hike the Philosopher's Path for panoramic views. Alternatively, visit Speyer with its Romanesque cathedral, or cycle to Ladenburg's medieval center. In the evening, cruise to Rüdesheim to marvel at Siegfried's Mechanical Instrument Cabinet or savour Rüdesheimer coffee, a delightful blend of brandy, coffee, and whipped cream.

FRIDAY, MAY 30

B, L, D

Join a wine tasting to discover the flavours of the town's iconic vineyards and drink up the stunning views by soaring high above the vineyards with a gondola ride to the Niederwalddenkmal. For a more active adventure, hike through the town's beautiful vineyards or join a guided bike tour along the scenic Rhine River. Later in the day, cruise through the captivating UNESCO-designated Rhine Gorge, the most stunningly beautiful stretch of the river before reaching Lahnstein, where you will enjoy a unique evening visit at Lahneck Castle.

SATURDAY, MAY 31

3. L. D

Cruise to Cologne and explore the Old Town on a guided tour, visiting landmarks like Cologne Rathaus, Fishmarkt, and Great St. Martin Church. End with a taste of Kölsch beer at a local tavern. Alternatively, take a guided tour highlighting Cologne's historic and modern architecture, including a visit to the Cologne Cathedral, a 13th-century Gothic marvel. For active guests, join a guided bike ride along the Rhine and through the historic Stadtgarten.

SUNDAY, JUNE 1

B, L, D

Experience Amsterdam's 165 canals on a canal cruise or savour Dutch specialties while passing iconic canals, gabled houses, narrow bridges, and houseboats at a grand cafe. Note: Tour may be replaced with a Jordaan District Walking Tour based on docking location.

Disembark ship and transfer to Amsterdam airport for return flight to Toronto.
