THURSDAY, MARCH 27

This morning, depart for a photo opportunity at The White House and National World War I Memorial, before enjoying a Cherry Blossom Cruise on the Odyssey III. Once docked continue the Cherry Blossom festivities with a Pink Stoll among the Japanese cherry blossom trees. Later, enjoy stops at the Martin Luther King, Jr National Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, the Franklin D. Roosevelt memorial, and the National World War II Memorial. Dinner on your own at The Wharf on the Potomac River, before returning to your hotel.

FRIDAY, MARCH 28

Start the morning with a drive past the Fords Theatre, Embassy Row and the Washington Cathedral. Enjoy a visit to the Hillwood Estate, Museum and Gardens, the mansion is the former home of cereal heiress Marjorie Merriweather Post. Later, visit Capitol Hill and its visitor Center. Lunch is on our own at the Capitol Visitor Center before taking a guided tour of The United States Capitol, which has housed congress since 1800. Tonight, enjoy dinner prior to an Illumination Monument Driving, with a walk-through Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.

SATURDAY, MARCH 29

B. D

In the morning, enjoy a later start to your day before visiting the Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center home to the National Air and Space Museum. Later, visit your choice of one of the Smithsonian Institution's Museums. Including National Gallery of Art, Freer & Sackler Gallery, Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden, National Museum of African Art, National Museum of American History, National Air & Space Museum or National Museum of Natural History. Before dinner stop at the Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Lincoln Memorial and Korean War Veterans Memorial. Explore The Mansion on O Street's. Dinner is included this evening.

SUNDAY, MARCH 30

Today, explore Arlington National Cemetery by tram with four stops including John F. Kennedy gravesite, U.S. Army General John J. Pershing's gravesite, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and the Ord & Weitzel walking gate to see the U.S Marien Crops War Memorial. Every hour, be witness to the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. In the afternoon, explore a different Smithsonian Institution's Museum than the previous day. In the evening, enjoy a Farewell Dinner.

MONDAY, MARCH 31

This morning, we bid farewell to Washington DC as we make our way home, taking frequent breaks. A stop will be made at the Duty-Free Shop before crossing into Canada.
