SUNDAY, APRIL 6

TUESDAY, APRIL 8

We start our morning tour of Historic Savannah with an Old Town Trolley Tour. In the afternoon, head to the Pinpoint Heritage Museum for a guided tour and discover coastal Georgia's rich Gullah-Geechee culture. The evening, enjoy the views and relax while sailing on the Savannah Riverboat Dinner Cruise.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 9

B

After breakfast, we depart our hotel, and head to Wormsloe Historic Site. Take in the breathtaking avenue sheltered by live oaks and Spanish moss which will lead to the tabby ruins for a guided tour. Later stop at the beautiful Forsyth Park for a photo-op. The afternoon and evening are free to shop and grab a bite to eat at City Market or stroll down River Street. THURSDAY, APRIL 10

After breakfast, depart for Charleston. This afternoon enjoy a city tour of Charleston. When arriving at the hotel enjoy a complimentary wine and cheese reception or evening milk and cookies. Explore Charleston on your own this evening.

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is due at the time of booking. Balance of payment is due February 5, 2025. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

February 6 to April 6	100% non-refundable
