- Athens, Greece** No modern metropolis is more steeped in myth than Athens. From the port of Piraeus to the Parthenon, eternal symbol of Western civilization, Athens has attracted adventurers and classicists for centuries. Sights include the ancient stadiums and temples, and millennia-old monuments are scattered in the archaeological park that circles the Acropolis.
- Thessaloniki, Greece** Tour the impressive historic sites of Thessaloniki is akin to rolling back history to the times of sweeping empires, mighty fortresses and imposing palaces. Dating back to 315 BC, the city is considered the cultural hub of Greece. Weaved in among the ancient ruins are vibrant streets lined with a diverse selection of delicious restaurants, boutique shops, popular festivals and beautiful beaches and scenic views of the sea.
- Izmir, Turkey** Archaeologically rich, historic Izmir dates back over 5,000 years. Virtually rebuilt from scratch in 1922, Izmir is a booming city today. The ancient city of Ephesus, home to the Artemis Temple and the Zeus Altar, is one of the world's best preserved archaeological sites.

- Istanbul, Turkey** There's a new aura of excitement in Istanbul, as this center of the Ottoman empire has become one the world's focal points for art, fashion, haute cuisine and nightlife. There is always an abundance of ancient monuments and grand mosques with stunning frescoes to see here, like the Hagia Sophia and Blue Mosque. Head to any park and you'll see why tulips have long been the symbol of this city.
- Mykonos, Greece** Mykonos is a classic Greek Island with white-washed houses, blue-domed churches and windmills. Add a reputation for beautiful beaches and you'll understand why Mykonos is the most popular island in the Cyclades. Explore the island in a 4 x 4 or take a ferry to the tiny island of Delos.
- Santorini, Greece** Whitewashed villages clinging to the sides of the sea cliffs have made the volcanic island of Santorini one of the most widely photographed places in the world. The island's charm and subtle mystery have even made it a target of speculation as the location of the lost city of Atlantis.
- Rhodes, Greece** This Greek Island just off the coast of Turkey exudes beauty and history. Take a walking tour of the old, fortified city and stand in awe of the impressive Grand Master's Palace. See where the Colossus of Rhodes, a one-time Wonder of the World, once stood and savor the charm of this remarkable walled town. Along the scenic coast lies the whitewashed town of Lindos with its ancient acropolis and stunning views.
- Heraklion (Crete), Greece** Although it's on the Greek Island of Crete, Heraklion offers a wealth of Venetian architecture from their rule in the 13th century, including magnificent, protected walls. Don't miss the Minoan Palace of Knossos Knossos, immortalized in Greek Mythology by the legend of the Minotaur.

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$900 per person is due at the time of booking. Balance of payment is due May 5, 2025. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to May 5	Deposit paid non-refundable
May 6 to June 9	50% non-refundable
June 10 to September 8	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
