Plantations in Louisiana are one of the most sought-after attractions throughout the state. The Houmas House Estate allows visitors to experience the life on a sugarcane plantation in the 1800's. The mansion has been restored to the antebellum era, reflecting the opulence and wealth this sugarcane farm boasted in the 1880's. After a guided tour, enjoy lunch. In the afternoon, visit the Oak Alley Plantation and immerse yourself in the 200+ years of history; before returning to the city of New Orleans.

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
