## FRIDAY, APRIL 24

Overnight flight, from Toronto to Madrid.

#### SATURDAY, APRIL 25

Start your tour to Spain and Portugal in Europe's highest capital city, Madrid. Spend the day walking along tree-lined boulevards and people-watching in the city's lively squares before a Welcome Dinner and orientation drive.

Accommodation: Barceló Imagine Madrid or similar

## SUNDAY, APRIL 26

Journey south for a trip to the hilltop city of Toledo, where we join a Local Specialist for a walking tour. Visit the Church of Santo Tomé, home to El Greco's most famous painting, 'The Burial of the Count of Orgaz', and visit the former synagogue of Santa Maria la Blanca. This afternoon, join a Local Specialist for a sightseeing tour of the Spanish capital Madrid, which includes views of the Royal Palace and the Cibeles Fountain.

#### MONDAY, APRIL 27

Venture to Segovia to see the Roman Aqueduct, by far the most impressive Roman structure in Spain - delivering drinking water to the people of Segovia in ancient times. View the Alcázar of Segovia. Travel to the city of Zamora in the Castile and Leon region and enjoy a walking tour which includes views of the Plaza Mayor and the Church of Mary Magdalene. Accommodation: NH Zamora Palacio del Duero or similar

### TUESDAY, APRIL 28

Travel to Santiago de Compostela, where a Local Specialist will join us and share insights into the 'Way of Saint James' and explain why thousands of people attempt the life-changing pilgrimage annually. Visit the vast Cathedral, believed to be the final resting place of Saint James the Great, and the Praza do Obradoiro, a square dominated by four architectural styles. Accommodation: Eurostars Gran Hotel Santiago de Compostela or similar

#### ■ WEDNESDAY, APRIL 29

Today, Dive Into Culture and centuries-old tradition of local Port production at a tasting in a Port cellar. Afterwards, embark on a sightseeing tour with a Local Specialist in Porto. Wander past Baroque churches and along the winding lanes that lead towards the Douro. See the remarkable bridges that span the river, the medieval Ribeira Quarter and its old dock, before visiting the Stock Exchange Palace with its splendid Arabian Hall inspired by Granada's Alhambra. Spend the rest of the afternoon strolling the historic center-steps away from your hotel.

Accommodation: Carris Porto Ribeira or similar

## THURSDAY, APRIL 30

Follow the road taken by pilgrims over the last 100 years to the Shrine at Fátima, site of a celebrated religious miracle. We arrive in colourful Lisbon later, our home for the next 2 nights.

Accommodation: VIP Grand Lisboa Hotel & Spa or similar

#### FRIDAY, MAY 1

Today, explore Lisbon's centuries-old seafaring heritage, paying tribute to the brave men who set off to discover a new world. See the shimmering white Monument to the Discoveries, the iconic suspension bridge spanning the River Tagus, and Belém Tower on a sightseeing tour of Lisbon with a Local Specialist. Dive Into Culture visiting Belém Quarter.

Travel east through Portugal's picturesque rural landscapes before crossing into Spain. Journey through the province of Huelva, renowned for its Jabugo ham, before arriving in Seville. With a fine example of Moorish architecture, the Alhambra complex was built during the 14th century towards the end of the Islamic rule in Spain. Wander through the exotic water gardens of the Generalife, the royal Summer Palace, once linked to the other palaces by a covered walkway across the ravine and admire the intricate design and detail around every turn.

#### ■ TUESDAY, MAY 5

This morning, travel to Guadix in the northern foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains to see the whitewashed troglodyte dwellings lodged in the ochre-colored cliffs of the surrounding area. Then travel to Valencia, where we'll stay overnight, and view the Bullring and admire the beautiful façade of the Modernist Estacion del Norte Train Station and the Serrano Tower. Embrace the city's spirit of innovation and stop to view the City of Arts and Sciences, a large-scale urban recreation center for culture and science, designed by Santiago Calatrava. Here enjoy horchata, the celebrated drink of Valencia, during a MAKE TRAVEL MATTER® Experience.

Head north along the coast through the Levant region and stop at Peñíscola, the 'City in the Sea', to view the ancient castle of the 'Spanish Pope', built by the Knights Templa. Continue along the Costa Dorada to Barcelona with its whimsical Gaudí architecture with a Local Specialist see the exterior of the unfinished La Sagrada Família before paying tribute to Christopher Columbus at the monument that bears his name.

Embrace the charm of Barcelona, ramble through El Born for delicious tapas or consider joining an Optional Experience to the mountaintop monastery of Montserrat to see the shrine of the Black Madonna or spend the day exploring the city's enchanting barrios.
