Famous for its numerous classical Buddhist temples, gardens, imperial palaces, Shinto shrines and traditional wooden houses. It's also known for formal traditions such as kaiseki dining, consisting of multiple courses of precise dishes.

Tokyo, Japan

Yokohama and Edo began life as sleepy fishing villages and now contemporary Tokyo may be the most astonishing city on earth. With its mix of ancient tradition and postmodern culture. From centuries-old gardens and cobblestone laneways that live in perfect harmony with soaring skyscrapers and dazzling neon lights. Kochi, Japan

The capital of Kochi Prefecture on the southern coast of Shikoku is small, friendly, and boasts several attractions of interest to travellers. Make sure to enjoy some Katsuo no tataki, Kochi's most famous dish, and visit the temple and botanical garden at Mount Godaisan. Visit Kochi Castle that sits at its very heart of the city which was completed in 1611.

Miyazaki, Japan

Miyazaki is the second warmest temperatures in Japan, which offers a playground of outdoor activities that take full advantage of its balmy breezes and aquamarine waters. A resort atmosphere permeates Miyazaki, fragranced by blooms from local botanical gardens. A Peace Tower, built with stones from throughout Asia anchors the city and Heiwadai Park it is one of the most noted landmarks. The options are endless in Miyazaki to soak up local color...or just soak up the sun!

Nagasaki, Japan

Nagasaki is rich in history and features beautiful seaside scenery and fabulous nighttime views from its mountain slopes. Enjoy secluded hot springs, fascinating museums, and ornate temples that live side by side in the city. Nagasaki has ten natural parks that grace the area, with unique festivals that can be experienced throughout the year. Walk through streets influenced by both Chinese and European cultures in this fascinating city.

Busan, South Korea

Busan is the second largest city in South Korea, and it's culture is a unique blend of old and new. Busan is a small society of South Korea, a nation whose startling economic success often obscures one of Asia's most sophisticated and venerable cultures. A premier trading port, adjacent to the Korean Straits and Japan, makes it an international metropolis. Experience the tranquility of Beomeosa Temple, or climb the Busan Tower in Yongdusan Park.

Toba, Japan

Toba, located at the northeastern end of the Shima-hanto Peninsula in Mie, flourished as the castle town of the Kuki family who ruled this region from the 16th century. It was also a landing spot for visitors on the sea route to Ise-jingu Shrine & belongs to Ise-Shima National Park.

Osaka, Japan

Osaka remains Japan's second largest city and a vital commercial center.
