MONDAY, JULY 20

Enjoy a full day of sightseeing in Banff and Yoho National Park, travelling along the Bow Valley Parkway. Yoho National Park offers magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the serene turquoise waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. Highlights also include Lake Louise and Takakkaw Falls. Return to Banff in the late afternoon.

TUESDAY, JULY 21

Board the motorcoach and enjoy a full day sightseeing tour along the magnificent Icefields Parkway. Among the highlights are Bow Lake, Athabasca Falls and the Columbia Icefields. This icefield is one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle as well as being one of the most accessible in North America. Here ride a unique Ice Explorer onto the Athabasca Glacier and learn more about its geological features. Continue along the Icefields Parkway to Jasper. Today enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour of Jasper. Highlights include Pyramid and Patricia Lakes, and the Athabasca viewpoint. The remainder of the day is free to explore more of Jasper National Park independently. Dinner is included tonight.

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office. A non-refundable deposit of \$900 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due April 17, 2026. Bookings made after April 17 will require full payment at time of booking. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:
