THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17

Overnight flight from Toronto to Barcelona, Spain

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 18

Arrive in Barcelona and check into your hotel. The afternoon and evening are free to relax and explore on your own.

Accommodation: Hotel U232 or similar

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19

Meet our local guide for a half day panoramic tour in Barcelona. Drive along Paseo de Gracia, one of the most important streets in Barcelona where you'll see the facades of Gaudí's emblematic buildings such as Casa Batlló and La Pedrera and visit Basilica de la Sagrada Familia. After, drive along Villa Olimpica and part of Barcelona's coast area. Then proceed to Plaza de España and Montjuic mountain, which was the Olympic Area in 1992. Continue your drive past along Montjuic castle, Montjuic stadium and stop in one of the viewpoints of the mountain that offers incredible views of the city. You have the afternoon and evening free to sightsee.

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20 B, L, D

Check out of your hotel and board the Norwegian Epic, your home away from home for the next 7 nights. Ship departs Barcelona at 5pm.

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 21 B, L, D

Enjoy the day in Provence, France. Located on the Mediterranean coast, Marseille is the oldest city in France and was founded in 600 BC. Among the many terracotta-roofed buildings lies many intriguing sights including the Cathedral of Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde. Other places well worth visiting are the city of Avignon and the quaint villages of Le Baux & Aix en Provence. Explore more of Marseille on a Shore Excursion. Ship will be docked from 7am to 5pm.

■ TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 22 B, L, D

Explore Nice/Monaco (Villefranche) which offers the chance to experience an enchanting example of the French Riviera's, nestled a mere 6km east of Nice. Stroll along the Old Harbour for majestic views of the Mediterranean. Experience Saint Michael's Church which houses many incredible artworks or relax on one of the local beaches. Hike up to Fort Du Mont Alban, a 16th-century structure overlooking the city. Ship will be docked from 7am to 6pm, please note this is a tender port.

■ WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 23 B. L. D

Visit the Tuscan region, Florence & Pisa, resplendent in art and history. What's even more fortunate is that all the main attractions in Florence are centrally located for the perfect walking tour. See Santa Croce, Piazza del Duomo and Michelangelo's David. Explore more of Florence & Pisa while the ship is docked 7am to 11:59pm

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 25 B, L, D

Visit the third largest city on the island of Sicily, Messina welcoming cruise ship visitors with its lovely harbour, extraordinary architecture which miraculously survived a horrendous earthquake and tidal wave in 1908. Stroll through Messina's Piazza Cairoli taking in magnificent fountains and cathedrals, or sip Marsala wine at a sidewalk cafe. Docked in port from 7am to 6pm.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 26 B, L, D

Salerno is as rich in history as it is vibrant in its surrounding landscapes. The site of ancient settlements, Salerno has been home to vast empires and was the site of Medieval Europe's first medical school. A trip here makes it easy to understand why countless people have been drawn to its location along the Gulf. Nestled between the mountains and the sea at the southeastern point of the famed Amalfi Coast, Salerno boasts sun-drenched beaches, nature reserves and parks, historic sites and delicious local cuisine. Docked in port from 7am to 6pm.

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 27

After breakfast, bid farewell to the Norwegian Epic, and check into our hotel in Rome. Today you have the afternoon and evening free to explore Rome.

Accommodation: The Hive Hotel Rome or similar

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28

After breakfast, enjoy a guided Panoramic tour of Rome. This includes a walking tour around the historical center, visiting some of the most famous and iconic squares of the city such as Spanish Square and its famous Spanish steps, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Colonna, the Pantheon and Piazza Navona . From the coach you will have a panoramic view of other highlights such as Venice Square, Teatro di Marcello, the Circus Maximum, the Terme di Caracalla. The afternoon and evening free.

After breakfast, bid farewell to Rome and head back home with an afternoon flight to Toronto.
