Take in over 50 focal points from Parliament Hill to the Canadian Museum of History, 24 Sussex Drive to the stunning Rideau Falls! This evening is free to explore Ottawa.

After breakfast, explore the Canadian Museum of History with a guided tour followed by free time to enjoy the museum.
