■ Amsterdam, Netherlands

Amsterdam, the beautiful capital of the Netherlands, has the wonderful atmosphere of a 17th-century city combined with the contemporary character of a modern metropolis. It is a treasure chest of superb architecture and is famous for its canals and extraordinary museums. ■ Oslo, Norway

■ Tallinn, Estonia

People have come here to trade since the English in 1627. Today, find designer fashion, fine jewelry, fragrances, electronics, and leather in this tax haven. Talented islanders produce exquisite art and collectables.

■ Helsinki, Finland

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$960 per cabin is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due, March 6, 2026. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to March 6	Deposit paid non-refundable
March 7 to April 7	50% non-refundable
April 8 to June 18	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
