

**TUESDAY, JUNE 2**

Arrive in Halifax and check into your hotel which is located in the downtown core of this vibrant and cosmopolitan urban centre on the Atlantic Ocean. Meet your local guide and fellow travelers this evening at a Meet & Greet.

**WEDNESDAY, JUNE 3**

Explore the Bay of Fundy and learn about the world's highest tides as you meander its colourful coastline to New Brunswick. En route, explore the Joggins Fossil Cliffs, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where magnificently exposed layers of rock reveal the world's most complete fossil record of life in the "Coal Age" of 300 million years ago. After arriving in New Brunswick, an unforgettable culinary experience awaits on a lobster boat. Continue to Moncton and check into your downtown hotel for the night.

**THURSDAY, JUNE 4**

**B, L**

Experience a true natural wonder this morning at the Hopewell Rocks on the coast of the Bay of Fundy. Marvel at these massive flower-pot shaped formations sculpted by the highest tides on the planet. Travel through Fundy National Park on to Canada's first incorporated city, Saint John, on the southern New Brunswick coast. Enjoy a city tour, including the Reversing Falls where twice daily the Bay of Fundy tides force the Saint John River to reverse its flow. Check into your home for the next two-nights. Enjoy dinner on your own.

**FRIDAY, JUNE 5**

**B, L**

Enjoy a day trip to picturesque St. Andrews by-the-Sea. After a Whale Watching Boat Tour (weather permitting), the afternoon is yours to experience the friendly people, beautiful architecture, and rich marine life of this seaside gem at your own pace.

**SATURDAY, JUNE 6**

**B, D**

This afternoon, arrive in Digby the scallop capital of the world, where the fresh sea air and passionate Acadian culture combine to form an enchanting and historically rich town. The hotel overlooks the Annapolis Basin on the Bay of Fundy.

**Accommodations:** Digby Pines Golf Resort & Spa or Similar

**SUNDAY, JUNE 7**

**B**

Travel the lush Annapolis Valley where the French Acadians of Grand Pre made their first settlement in the early 1600's. Learn about this landscape's designation as a UNESCO World Heritage Site as fact and fiction blend to reveal the romance of the Land of Evangeline. Visit a local winery for a tour and tasting before returning to Halifax for the evening.

**MONDAY, JUNE 8****B**

Enjoy breakfast in Peggy's Cove. Travel the South Shore and on to the UNESCO World Heritage Town of Lunenburg, renowned for her fleets of Grand Banks' fishing schooners. Take a walking tour and visit the Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic to learn about the town's famous seafaring heritage.

**TUESDAY, JUNE 9****B, D**

Learn about the Mi'kmaq people at Millbrook Cultural & Heritage Centre before crossing Confederation Bridge, to Prince Edward Island. Upon arrival in Charlottetown, enjoy a guided city walking tour. Then experience true Maritime hospitality at a traditional lobster supper.

**Accommodations:** Rodd Royalty Charlottetown or Similar

**WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10****B**

This morning, tour the scenic North Shore. Drive by red cliffs, white beaches, gently sloping sand dunes and green fields of Prince Edward Island National Park. Then visit Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place before returning to Charlottetown this afternoon for a performance of Anne & Gilbert. This evening is yours to explore Charlottetown at your own pace.

**THURSDAY, JUNE 11****B, D**

Ferry over the Northumberland Strait back to Nova Scotia and proceed to Cape Breton Island, the Scotland of North America. Upon arrival in Baddeck, visit Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site to learn of the many accomplishments of this genius who made his home on the island.

**Accommodations:** Inverary Resort Baddeck or similar

**FRIDAY, JUNE 12****B, L, D**

This morning, see the beautiful Bras d'Or Lake from the water as you board a unique sightseeing boat tour. Then, experience one of the most stunningly picturesque drives in North America as you tour the Cabot Trail of Cape Breton's northern shore, ascending to the incredible plateaus of Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Look-outs offer unforgettable vistas of Cape Breton's rugged coastline so be sure to have your camera on hand.

**SATURDAY, JUNE 13****B**

Explore the Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site, the reconstruction depicting one fifth of the settlement of 1744 New France. After proceed back to Halifax for one last night in the Maritimes.

**How to book:** Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due, April 3, 2026. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

**Cancellation charges:** Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to April 3, 2026	Deposit paid non-refundable
April 4 to 0 days prior	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

**Local laws and customs:** The Government of Ontario requires that residents travelling out of province to be advised that there may be different living standards with respect to the provision of utilities, services and accommodations outside of Ontario. Travel Act Regulation 38(06)

**Moderate Pace:** Tour requires average physical activity. Traveler should be in good physical health, able to climb stairs, be comfortable standing, and walking moderate distances including uneven surfaces. Itineraries typically include more longer than shorter days.
