Enjoy free time to for lunch along the riverfront. Later head to Fort Malden National Site in Amherstburg for a guided tour of the Fort including a musket firing demonstration. Dinner is included tonight.



■ WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 12

After breakfast, begin the day visiting the Willstead Manor, there have a guided tour that explains the history of the 36-room mansion that sits within the 15-acres on Willstead Park. Next, explore Windsor and Detroit’s skyline on a scenic sightseeing cruise on the Detroit river. Finish your day with a guided tour of the Ojibway Nature Center. Evening is free to explore on your own.

■ THURSDAY, AUGUST 13

After breakfast we depart from the hotel for our last attraction, The Rum Runners tour. This award winning theatrical adventure takes us to the past of Windsor’s prohibition era with back-alley stories and larger-than-life characters. Later make our way home with new memories! Rest stops will be made along the journey home.
