How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$1500 per cabin is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due, October 16, 2026. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to October 16	Deposit paid non-refundable
October 17 to November 16	50% non-refundable
November 17 to February 25	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
