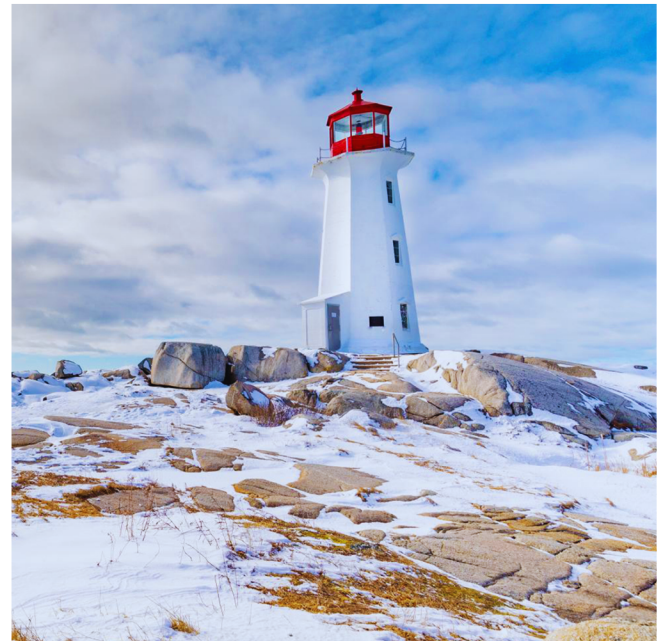

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due, September 21, 2026. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to September 21	Deposit paid non-refundable
September 22 to December 4	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.

Local laws and customs: The Government of Ontario requires that residents travelling out of province to be advised that there may be different living standards with respect to the provision of utilities, services and accommodations outside of Ontario. Travel Act Regulation 38(06)

Active Pace: Tour requires extensive physical activity. Traveller should be in good physical health, able to climb stairs, be comfortable standing, and walking long distances including uneven surfaces. Itineraries typically include more longer days.
