After a day surrounded in nature, return to Arenal for the chance to relax at your resort.

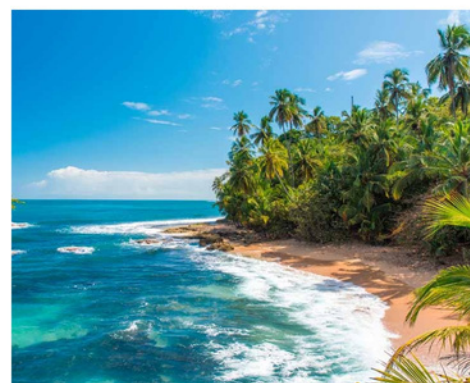

October 2 to January 18	100% non-refundable
