Terms and Conditions

How to book: Reservations may be made through any CAA Niagara office with a travel agent. A non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 per person is due at time of booking. Balance of payment is due April 16, 2027. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of travel insurance. Ask for details.

Cancellation charges: Should it be necessary to cancel your trip prior to departure, the following penalties will apply:

Prior to April 17	Deposit paid non-refundable
April 17 to May 16	50% non-refundable
May 17 to August 5	100% non-refundable

The day of departure is excluded when calculating cancellation charges. CAA strongly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance.
