DAY 1 - Depart Toronto Depart from Toronto on KLM to Nairobi, flying via Amsterdam.

DAY 2 - Amsterdam/Nairobi On arrival in Amsterdam, connect with your flight to Nairobi. At Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met by a Lion World Travel representative and transferred to the 5-star Nairobi Serena Hotel, a member of the Leading Hotels of the World and well known for its exceptional standards of service and hospitality.

Accommodation: Nairobi Serena Hotel - Standard Room

DAY 3 - Nairobi/Sweetwaters After breakfast, transfer to Sweetwaters Serena Camp located in a private conservancy, one of the most exclusive tented safari camps in Kenya. Your accommodation will be in upgraded Morani luxury tents, each with its own private veranda overlooking the water hole. This afternoon, enjoy a visit to the Jane Goodall Chimpanzee Sanctuary during your safari game drive.

Accommodation: Sweetwaters Serena Camp – Morani Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 4 - Sweetwaters/Lake Elmenteita After breakfast, transfer to Serena Lake Elmenteita Luxury Camp, situated beside the sapphire-blue Lake Elmenteita, where thousands of birds congregate. Enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Soysambu Conservancy. On the way back, enjoy a half hour open bar cocktail stop.

Accommodation: Serena Lake Elmenteita Luxury Camp – Standard Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 5 -Lake Elmenteita After breakfast, enjoy a game drive

in Lake Nakuru National Park. Stop for lunch at Sarova Lion Hill Lodge. After lunch, you will be taken on a short game drive back to Lake Elmenteita where you will take part in an interactive cooking class. Enjoy dinner and overnight at the camp.

Accommodation: Serena Lake Elmenteita Luxury Camp – Standard Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 6 - Lake Elmenteita/Maasai Mara After breakfast, drive to the Maasai Mara National Reserve, home to beautiful scenery and an abundance of game. Arrive in time for lunch at Mara Serena Lodge. Styled to echo the circular motif of a traditional Maasai manyatta, the lodge blends international sophistication with raw African beauty, with each room having its own view of the famous Mara river. Each room is its own stand-alone modular unit, with uninterrupted views, private balcony and spacious seating area. The dining areas offer spectacular views, along with the rock-surround swimming pool. Spend the afternoon on safari in Kenya's most popular reserve. Arrive back at the camp in time for a hot shower, campfire cocktails and dinner in the luxurious central restaurant.

Accommodation: Mara Serena Safari Lodge – Standard Room (B, L, D)

DAY 7 - Maasai Mara During your stay, enjoy a hippo pool breakfast. After a cup of tea in the morning, leave the lodge and enjoy an exciting safari in the morning. Arriving on the banks of the Mara River, you will be met by a traditionally clad Maasai warrior who will lead you along the river to your table with a full breakfast, located in a shady grove alongside a hippo pool. After breakfast, experience another game drive on your way back to the lodge. All of the "Big Five", lion, rhino, buffalo, elephant and leopard, are here as

well as many others. The Mara is also notable for its abundance of lions, especially the superb black-maned males. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon safari game drive.

Accommodation: Mara Serena Safari Lodge – Standard Room (B, L, D)

DAY 8 - Maasai Mara The Maasai Mara is an extension of the world-renowned Serengeti National Park in Tanzania. Named for the Maasai tribes' people and the Mara river which divides it, the reserve is famous for its exceptional population of game and the annual migration of the wildebeest. The Maasai Mara offers wonderful scenery of breathtaking vistas, panoramas of vast rolling plains, hills and woodland groves all watered by the lovely Mara River. The waters of the Mara River are home to crocodiles and pools of hippo, while the woodlands and forests are favored by leopard and elephant. The open savannah areas play host to the plains game. After a relaxing day at the camp, you will head out on another game drive in the late afternoon.

Accommodation: Mara Serena Safari Lodge - Standard Room (B, L, D)

DAY 9 - Maasai Mara/Ngerende/Bogani After breakfast, depart to Bogani Cottages and Tented Camp. On arrival you will meet your Lion World Travel/ME to WE representative at the Ngerende Airstrip and transfer to Bogani. Bogani offers a completely different experience compared to Kenya's safari camps by providing a genuine opportunity to get involved with the local community. Bogani is located to the north of the Maasai Mara, surrounded by open countryside and local villages. There are five large family cottages and 18 safari tents, all surrounded by open countryside.



ME to WE

Enjoy lunch on the veranda overlooking the savannah before your orientation, walking Bogani's winding paths under yellow acacia groves. After lunch, visit a local primary school. Experience a guided walking tour in the Enlerai community, and see the difference between an old school and a new school built by ME to WE.

Accommodation: Bogani Cottages and Tented Camp - Bogani Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 10 - Bogani (ME to WE) Join the mamas at Emori Joi for a special walk through the community. Learn more about how the Kipsigis organize their homes and lives. Fetch water from the Mara River with the mamas, a task the women perform daily. This will be followed by lunch with the mamas where you can participate in a discussion about changes taking place in the community.

Spend some time deepening your impact at the build site in the afternoon. Roll up your sleeves and work alongside the Maasai and Kipsigi community members as you help to build a new school.

Accommodation: Bogani Cottages and Tented Camp - Bogani Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 11 - Bogani (ME to WE) In the morning there will be a visit to an authentic Kenyan market to learn about the economic environment in which the community members live. In the afternoon, you will continue working at the build site of a new school. After that there will be a visit to the Baraka Medical Clinic and Medicinal Garden. The clinic serves over 30,000 community members, promoting healthy living and providing preventative, curative and rehabilitative services to the most vulnerable segments of the Kenyan population. These services enable individuals and communities to enhance their health.

Accommodation: Bogani Cottages and Tented Camp - Bogani Tent (B, L, D)

DAY 12 - Bogani/Nairobi/Depart Go on a sunrise hike before you say farewell to this incredible experience, and your new friends in the community. There will also be a short debrief on your community experience with your facilitators.

Depart from Bogani to the airstrip for your short light aircraft flight to Nairobi. On arrival in Nairobi you will have lunch and visit the Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage where you will get the chance to see these fascinating animals up close.

Accommodation: Ole Sereni Hotel - Dayroom (B, L)

DAY 13 - Arrive Home Arrive in Amsterdam and then connect to your ongoing KLM flight to Toronto. Arrive home with a lifetime of memories!

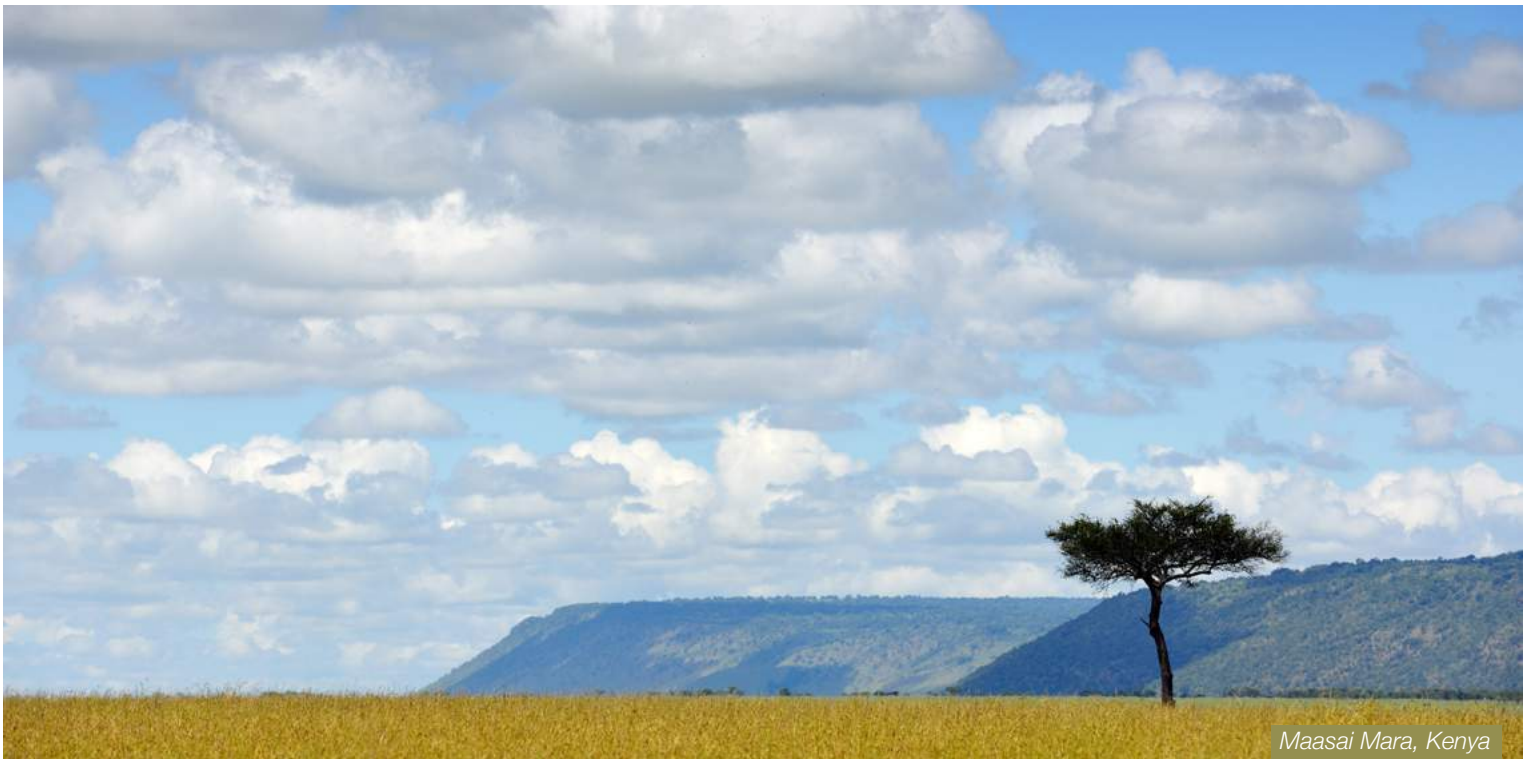
