Then head to Sete Cidades, discover the incredible viewpoint of Boca do Inferno, one of the best on the island. Then arrive at the famous King's view, a mandatory stop to any Azores visitor. After lunch, proceed to view the beautiful rocks of Mosteiros.

Saturday, April 13

Begin with the ascent of the "Pico da Barrosa", one of the highest peaks of the island, which offers an extraordinary view of the "Lagoa do Fogo" (Lake of Fire). Descent to the pond is by a short, steep, narrow trail. Before leaving, you will have time to dive into the waters of this beautiful lagoon. Continue to Ribeira Grande, to visit the town center, see the beautiful cliffs, and visit the largest beach in the Azores.

Sunday, April 14

Travel to the the Furnas area, to see the volcanic attractions of the lake, the hot springs and the holes in the ground where local specialty "Cozido nas Caldeiras" is cooked for seven hours by underground volcanic steam. Continue to the town of Furnas for lunch. Option to stroll the historic botanical gardens (additional charge) planted in the 18th century and take the opportunity to swim in the hot springs. Travel to the north coast, stopping for a great view and visit Europe's only tea plantation.

Monday, April 15

Travel from Ponta Delgada with our first stop at Ribeira dos Caldeirões. Here, view the beautiful waterfall Véu da Noiva and visit the traditional watermills. Travel through Nordeste's village towards the eastern tip of the island. The lunch will be in Povoação's village, the first place to be settled on the island. In the afternoon, visit its historic center.

Tuesday, April 16

Today is free to explore San Miguel Island. Enjoy a farewell dinner at local restaurant including drinks.

Wednesday, April 17

Bid farewell to the Azores as you begin your journey home.




